<u>Doctolib</u>

Doctolib is a website available in France, Italy and Germany. Through the app, the user can make a medical appointment fully online with any kind of doctor and practitioner. Doctolib also allows to have online consultations.

Doctolib is very useful, as it serves not only as a booking platform for finding doctors and making appointments, but also gives doctors quick access to patient records and appointment history, helping them manage appointments, refer patients to colleagues, exchange patient information online, and more. This makes health care even easier for the user!

Doctolib step by step

- Go to the Doctolib website.
- If you are new to Doctolib, you will have to make an account, by selecting the option on the far right of your screen.
- Click on "Subscribe" and add your information: telephone number, email address, date of birth, and a password you will remember.
- Accept terms of use.
- Type in your email address or phone number.
- A code will be sent to this number to validate your account.
- Type that code and you will have an account!
- Once you have created your account, you are ready to search for a doctor, by name, establishment, specialty, or location!

Notes can only be used on any Apple device, iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch.

With Notes, you can capture a quick thought, create checklists, sketch ideas, and more. And with iCloud, you can keep your notes updated across all your devices. Evernote has a more cluttered interface because of its features, while Apple Notes tries to be minimalist by offering a simple interface with a notes list and a search bar.

Notion is a similar note-taking web application. It organisational tools including offers task management, project tracking, to-do lists. bookmarking, and more. Additional offline features are offered by desktop and mobile applications available for Windows, macOS, Android, and iOS. Users can create custom templates, embed videos and web content, and collaborate with others in real time. Evernote is more suitable for taking individual notes and organising note-related tasks, whereas Notion provides an an-encompassing workspace to empower team collaboration, task management, and knowledge organization.



Google Calendar

Scheduling service for meetings. You can view multiple calendars in one view. Everyone you know who has the service can view your calendar.

Google Calendar is a great tool as it provides a way to keep all your appointments organized. It helps to manage work and personal life. Even when you purchase tickets online for an event, it will automatically add it to your calendar. It's an easy tool to use. It's free so no cost to use.

Google Calendar step by step

- Go to the website provided for Google Calendar if you already have a Gmail account or create a Gmail account first.
- Under Workspace look for Calendar.
- Click Add Calendar followed by create calendar.
- Start filling in by month and day your meetings and life events.
- Click Create to have it saved.
- You can follow by sharing with others through access creation.
- You give access by entering the Gmail addresses of others.
- Next you will need to select an option of what they can see.

Monday is a platform that allows you to create applications and manage projects. It's more flexible than Google Calendar. You have more options for collaboration features for projects.

Google Keep is a free app developed by Google that allows you to keep your thoughts, groceries, or lists all in one place. You can set a location-based reminder to pull up your grocery list right when you get to the store. You can set also a time-based reminder to make sure you never miss a thing or to make a to-do list. You can create notes in a variety of formats including text, lists, images, and voice memos. Which makes this app accessible to all levels of users and across generations and abilities.

Google Keep also integrates with other Google apps like Google Docs, Google Sheets, and Google Slides. Which allows the user to easily transfer content from one app to another.

Google Keep also allows you to share your notes or your lists and it's totally free. Useful and simple. This app can help members of community groups with setting reminders for upcoming events, any actions that may need to be taken, and jot down any notes that may come up at meetings.

- Go to the Google Play Store or the App Store and search for "Google Keep."
- Install the app by clicking on the "Install" or "Get" button.

Google Maps is a web service that provides detailed information about geographical regions and sites worldwide. In addition to conventional road maps, Google Maps offers aerial and satellite views of many locations. In some cities, Google Maps offers street views comprising photographs taken from vehicles. Google Maps can be used for numerous modes of transport including (walking, cycling, driving, and public transit). Frequently used locations can be saved in the app and there is also a great feature that allows the user to share their trip progress to make navigation easier.

Google Maps can let you see the traffic situation on your route indicating colors blue, yellow, orange, and red show the flow of traffic from free flowing to high congestion.

Google Maps is a great tool when someone is attending a new event or location if the person is not familiar with the area and can offer comfort to those using it in this situation.



- Open Google Play or Apple App Store.
- Search "Google Maps" and install or get the app.
- Sign in to your Google account within the Maps app.
- Search for the location you want the directions for
- Tap the name or address of the location.
- Tap the three horizontal dots at the top right corner of the screen
- Select "download" to save offline map
- Access your offline map by tapping on your profile icon in the top right corner of the screen and selecting "Offline Maps".

The portal is available in Greek and English and is user-friendly both for older adults and migrants living in Greece. With easy-to-follow tutorials, gov.gr is constantly evolving, improving, and updating based on the comments, suggestions, and evaluations of visitors. In this way, gov. gr brings together all the solutions and everything that citizens and businesses dealing with the public sector need to know.

gov.gr step by step

- For simply seeking information, all the user needs are a device and a connection to the internet. 11 categories with 1579 digital public services, are available on the home page to help users find exactly what they are looking for. Also, if one doesn't know in which category to look, there is an easy-to-use search bar.
- For more complicated services, e.g., to access their Electronic Personal Health Record and make a medical appointment, the user needs to log in to the application portal with the credentials issued by their family doctor.
- For other transactions, their social security number is required.

Kuri is a cooking application that aims to make home cooking more accessible and enjoyable. With a wide range of recipes from various cuisines, Kuri provides step-by-step instructions, ingredient lists, and cooking tips to guide users through the cooking process. The app also allows users to personalize their recipe collections according to their dietary preferences and restrictions, create shopping lists, and save their favorite recipes for future use. Kuri also proposes low-carbon and seasonal dishes. It strives to inspire beginner and experienced cooks to explore new dishes.

The app provides a user-friendly interface and clear instructions, making it accessible and easy to navigate for individuals who may be less familiar with technology. By using Kuri, seniors and migrants can learn how to search for recipes, follow cooking instructions, and use various features of the app, thereby enhancing their digital skills and helping bridge the digital divide.

As food concerns everyone and is a great convener, a food app can serve as a gateway to the online world, helping become more comfortable with technology, which in turn allows seniors to access a wealth of online resources, and connect with others. Kuri can be used during intergenerational meetings where young people, migrants, and seniors share their culinary and digital competences and cultures. They can use the app as a platform to teach cooking skills, share recipes, and guide others through the cooking process.

KURI step by step

- Go to your app store (iOS) and search for "Kuri." Download and install the app on your smartphone or tablet
- Open the Kuri app and sign up for an account. Provide the required information, such as your name, email address, and password. You may have the option to sign up using your social media accounts as well
- Once you've created your account, the app may prompt you to set your food preferences to tailor recipe recommendations based on your dietary restrictions, allergies, or cuisine preferences.
- After setting your preferences, you'll be taken to the home screen or recipe library. Here, you can browse through a wide range of recipes available on the app. You can scroll through the suggested recipes or use the search bar to find specific dishes
- Choose a recipe that catches your interest. Tap on it to view the detailed recipe page. The page will display the ingredients, stepby-step instructions, and cooking time. You can also visualize the nutritional information on the receipt by clicking on the flash. You can also change the number of people you are cooking for to adapt the quantities
- In the receipt you have the option to add the ingredients to your shopping lists that you can then find by clicking on trolley. You can share the list with your family or friends.
- Start preparing the recipe by following the provided instructions. Kuri will guide you through each step, indicating the required ingredients, quantities, and cooking techniques
- If you come across a recipe that you particularly enjoy, you can save it as a favorite for future reference by clicking on the heart
- Look for the "Preferences" section, where you can modify your dietary restrictions, and cooking level, or adjust portion sizes according to your needs

Young people can also assist seniors and migrants in navigating the app, exploring different beauty and wellness services, and booking appointments.

Treatwell step by step

- Visit your app store (iOS or Android) and search for "Treatwell." Download and install the app.
- Open the app and sign up. Provide the required information, such as your name, email address, and password.
- Allow Treatwell to access your location or manually enter your city or postal code. This step helps the app display salons in your area.
- Once your location is set, you can search for the beauty salon you are looking for, let's say a hair salon. You can use the search bar or the several categories displayed.
- Tap on a service that you're interested in to view more details (haircuts, coloring, etc.).
- You can click on "availibilities" to find available dates and times for appointments. Choose a suitable date and time slot that works for you.
- Before finalising the booking, review the details of the appointment, including the service, date, and time. Ensure that everything is accurate. When ready, tap the "Book" or "Confirm" button.
- Some salons may require payment at the time of booking. If this is the case, follow the prompts to enter your payment information securely.
- Once your booking is complete, you should receive a confirmation message or email. This confirmation will include the appointment details, salon address, and any additional instructions provided by the salon. It's a good idea to save or screenshot this information for reference.
- If you liked the service, you can add the salon in your list of favourites (the heart) to find it easily on when you need to rebook and appointment.

<u>Watizat</u>

Watizat is a French-based NGO that campaigns for access to information for people living in exile in France. They recognise that information is a vital resource that can have a major impact on people's lives, especially when they are foreign nationals living in precarious conditions. The transmission of correct and translated information can facilitate people's access to their rights and give them a better understanding of the services and players present in the area. Therefore, they create several informational supports (leaflets, videos, audios, etc.) and in several languages (French, English, Dari, Arabic, Pachto) to help people in exile get in connection with local actors, communities, and administrations.

Through its focus on providing information to individuals in exile, Watizat helps combat social exclusion. By empowering migrants with access to essential information, services, and local communities, it ensures that individuals facing language or cultural barriers can still benefit from essential services and resources available digitally and help them to better integrate into society and reduce social isolation. This can foster a sense of belonging and inclusion, reducing the risk of social exclusion.

Watizat's informational resources can also serve as valuable topics for mentorship. Young people and seniors can get involved in the NGO, collecting information, organizing them, and communicating them both online or during events, meetings, and raids, helping migrants and other individuals in exile. Seniors can share their knowledge of their towns and regions, of the administrative system, and young people can use their knowledge in nowadays communication channels (Youtube, TikTok) to make the resources as much accessible as possible. By helping migrants access services, and understand their rights, young mentors can shift from being passive technology consumers to active mentors, supporting others in their digital journey.

- Open your web browser and navigate to the Watizat website by entering the URL: <u>https://watizat.org/</u>.
- Upon reaching the website, you can change the language in the top right corner from French to English or English to French.
- Use the menu bar access different sections and resources: "Qui sommes-nous?" (About Us), "Nos guides" (Our guides), "Nos vidéos", or "Nous contacter" (contact us).
- Navigate to the "Nos guides" (Our guides) section to view or download the PDF guides, available for several cities in France. The guide relays accurate information on the procedure of claiming asylum, demanding a long-stay visa. It also provides addresses and advice that is useful for daily routines (legal help, food charities, healthcare, showers, day-time shelters, French language courses, etc.) The guide aims to place refugees in touch with local organizations that can help bring aid to them. Different sections of the guide have been directly worked on with refugees so that it is best able to address their needs.
- You can also click on the "Vidéos" section to access the Youtube and Tiktok accounts where summary videos are available in several languages and provide how-to content for recurrent problems people in exile may encounter.
- If you have questions, need further assistance, or have suggestions for content, visit the "Contact Us" section to send a message to the Watizat team
- If the website offers language options, look for a language selector or flags representing different languages.

For example, Wizbii Jobs is designed to support young professionals in their career development and facilitate connections with employers. It offers job search tools and networking opportunities.


It is also available in Spanish and English.

Wizbii step by step to find a job



Canva step by step

- Visit the Canva website and sign up for a new account. Once you've created an account, log in to access the Canva dashboard.
- On the Canva dashboard, you'll see a variety of design types to choose from. These include social media posts, presentations, flyers, posters, and more. Select the design type that best suits your needs, or you can start with a blank canvas if you prefer.

Jig Saw Planet step by step

- Every piece can be caught and dropped by the left mouse button in two ways:
 - Place the cursor over the piece, press and hold the left mouse button. Now you can move the piece arbitrarily but you still have to hold the left mouse button. Along with releasing the button you will drop the piece.
